POV CALL RESPONSE GUIDELINES

- Complete initial 2-hour orientation with assigned mentor
- Complete assigned POV (Personally operated vehicle), blood borne pathogens and sexual harassment online training modules with assigned time frame.
- Complete EVOC online training if training on department apparatus
- Utilize I am Responding app when responding.
- Respond only to calls dispatched in the Town of Willington.
- You shall not respond to calls on Interstate 84.
- You shall not respond to calls dispatched as Covid positive or “PUI” person under investigation of Covid.
- You shall drive with due regard and follow all applicable driving laws
- Wear proper attire that identifies you as a member of the department.
- If you arrive before the ambulance, stage a safe distance away until Willington Fire Dept personnel arrive on scene.
- When dispatched to “Stage for CSP” please stage away from the scene and wait until TN advises.
- If you arrive after the ambulance, park a reasonable distance away to allow for other resources and do not block any driveway.
- If you ride the call into the hospital, please return to the station to help restock and decon the apparatus as needed.
- If you respond to a fire call, please park a safe distance away to allow for multiple fire apparatus and do not block any driveways.
- Upon arrival on scene of a fire call, check in with Incident command or a fire officer of Willington Fire Dept.
- If you respond to a fire call, check with a Willington Fire Officer if you need to return to the station for decon or to help put an apparatus back in service.
- Please continue to schedule precepting hours to complete Ambulance attendant training.
